1947

He was given his first camera.  
His father taught him how to develop and print the first results.

After school decided to go to a film school, IDHEC, in Paris.  
His teacher was M. Mundvill, who Had started his career in silent films and was one of the cameramen on "Napoleon" with Abel Gance.

He stayed at the school for a year before starting in his first job as an assistant. A year and a half later he found himself with a camera in his hands, photographing documentary films in Latin America for German TV.

1963

He came home and was asked to photograph a movie almost straight away:  
"It Happened Here" with Kevin Brownlow directing.

1965

He was asked to shoot a colour movie by Peter Watkins, called "Privilege".

He shot nearly fifty films including "The Empire Strikes back", "The Rocky Horror Picture Show", two films with John Boorman, " Mars Attacks" with Tim Burton, and nine films with David Cronenberg.
